San Francisco is served by the San Francisco Unified School District, which is home to over 160 public pre-Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade schools in the city. There are also a multitude of universities and colleges in the city, including public universities such as University of California @ San Francisco, City College of San Francisco, and San Francisco State University. Some private universities in the city are Golden Gate University, New College of California, the California School of Culinary Art, and a number of private art schools.
